Originally created to conserve native Arabian wildlife, the zoo has evolved into a modern conservation, education, and research center spanning over 400 hectares. It houses thousands of animals, with a strong focus on endangered species from the Arabian Peninsula and Africa, including the Arabian Oryx and other desert-adapted wildlife.]*
- 19:15 Transfer back to Abu Dhabi and/or AUH airport.
